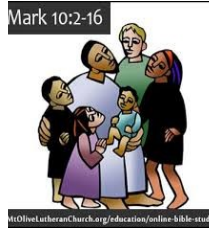

This year's theme, chosen by Pope Francis, is rooted in the Gospel of Matthew: "Go and Invite Everyone to the Banquet," reflecting the inclusive and urgent call to bring God's love to everyone. - ♦ **Sat 5th October: St. Faustina** was born in Glogowiec, near Lodz in Poland in 1905 and died in Krakow in 1938. She inspired the movement dedicated to proclaiming and imploring Divine Mercy throughout the world.
- ♦ **Mon 7th October: Our Lady of the Rosary** urges us to meditate on the mysteries of Christ, following the example of the BVM.
- ♦ **Fri 11th October: St. John XXIII** born in Bergamo 1881 and elected Pope 28th Oct 1958. Called the Second Vatican Council in October 1962. Died 3rd June 1963
