Notes of Explanation

- This statement for Drumlish/Ballinamuck Parish Current Accounts reflects the day to day running of the Parish.
- Income v Expenses for the past year left us with a total running loss of b43.335.52 (Offertory collection was down b4.419.50 on 2012)
- ✓ * Includes repairs and upgrading to both parish houses
- ** Sundry expenses include: Contribution of b1,000 to FAS, Office Equipment, Fire Safe for Records, Alarm et al.
- *** Copy of the Contract is posted at back of the Church. Due to some unplanned extras, including the refurbishing of the statues, provision of risers and treads to steps of the sanctuary, 6 stools etc. we over ran the estimate slightly.
- The Six Dues Collections for the upkeep of the 2 priests totalled p25,825.54. In real terms your Dues for the past year worked out at b12,912.77 per priest per year or p248.32 per week per priest. As each priest in the Diocese receives a salary of p21,600 per year, we are heavily subsidised here in the parish of Drumlish/Ballinamuck. A minimum of p10 for each dues collection is not unrealistic. Alternative Dues envelopes are provided at the back of the churches for those who dong use the normal envelope system, but still wish to support the priests of the parish. We thank all parishioners who continue to support us through their prayers, encouragement and financial support. If you use the services of the priests and parish facilities, but for some reason have overlooked the support of the parish and its priests, we ask you to reflect on this in 2014.
- In 2013 the parish, as a charitable institution, reclaimed þ19,309.92 from the Revenue on taxes paid by PAYE workers from the parish. This was for the years 2009ô 2012. In the last Budget (2013) this system was modified and extended to include PAYE workers, self employed, pensioners and all who pay taxes and who contribute þ250 to the parish and/or its clergy during the financial year. The tax rate has also been modified, with a cap of 30% all round (no longer a higher and lower rate). This will be further clarified at a later date. Again, we need you to use the envelope system of collection so that we can have a paper trail and provide evidence of monies taken in. Money not paid through the envelope system is not optimisedô tax cannot be reclaimed on it and therefore is money lost to the parish.
- We thank you again for your continued generous support both on a personal level, through your prayers and financially.
