

Advent


This weekend we begin the season Advent, the four weeks of preparation for the celebration of the birth of Christ at Christmas time.



The Advent wreath is a circular garland of evergreen branches representing eternity. On that wreath, five candles are typically arranged. Each candle represents an aspect of the spiritual preparation for the coming of light of Christ into the world. On the first Sunday of Advent, the first purple candle is lit. This candle is called the "Prophecy Candle" in remembrance of the prophets, primarily Isaiah, who foretold the birth of Christ. This candle represents hope or expectation in anticipation of the coming Messiah.
