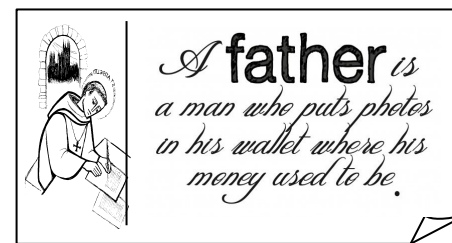

## Retreat

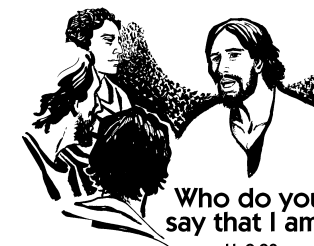
