Tax Refund

The tax refund system, whereby the Parish as a charitable institution, can claim back tax on contributions of €250 or more per year is of immense value to parishes. The system requires that those who support the church use the envelope system so that a paper trail can support any tax reclaim. For the years 2013, 2014, 2015 the parish of Drumlish/Ballinamuck benefited to the sum of €19,716.25. If more people were the use the envelope system that sum could be even larger.
