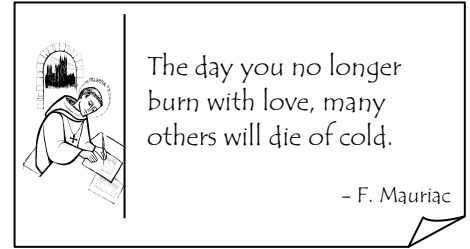
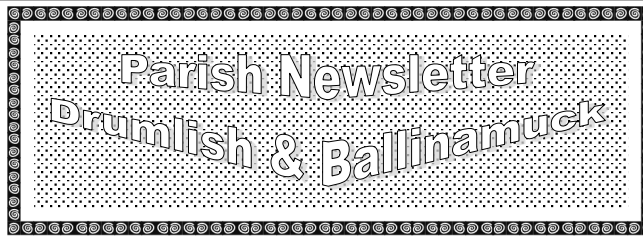

### Feast Days this Week

- † Wednesday is the feast of All Saints and is a holy day. Vigil Mass in Drumlish on Tuesday at 8 p.m. and Mass on Wednesday at 11 a.m. Mass in Ballinamuck on Wednesday at 7 p.m.
- † Thursday is the feast of All Souls. Mass in Drumlish on Thursday at 9.30 a.m. and 8 p.m. Mass in Ballinamuck at 7 p.m.
- † Indulgences may be gained by doing the following: From 12 o'clock on 1 November until midnight on 2 Nov., all who have a) confessed, b) received Communion c) prayed for the Pope's intentions (one Our Father and Hail Mary, or any other prayer of one's choice) can gain one plenary indulgence - applicable only to the souls of the departed - by visiting a church or oratory and there reciting one Our Father and the Apostle's Creed. From 1 - 8 November the faithful who visit a cemetery and pray for the dead may gain a plenary indulgence once per day - applicable only to the Holy Souls. Conditions a, b, c, above apply also.
