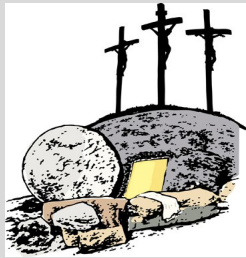
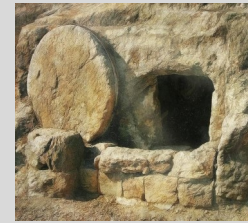

Welcome and Happy Easter

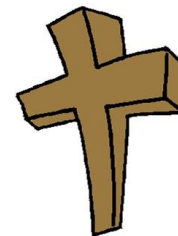
