St. Gall

Saint Gall was one of twelve missionaries who accompanied St Columbanus to Europe. While Columbanus went on to Italy, Gall remained in Switzerland, as a hermit. After his death, an abbey was founded and around it the town of St Gall developed. His contribution and that of his companions was immense. They brought learning and books which were reproduced across Europe. Many of the original texts in Ireland were destroyed by the Vikings but survived in Europe.
