#### Notes of Explanation

This statement for Drumlish/Ballinamuck Parish Accounts reflects the day to day running of the Parish. [Insurances, Maintenance, Heating & Lighting, Capital Expenditure and Levies to the Diocese etc.].

- Income v Expenses for the past year left us with a total running surplus of €50.620.04
- The Parish also has a fixed term deposit in TSB of €23,625.97 which, combined with the above balance leaves the parish with total assets
  of €182.301.40
- The Account in the Arva Credit Union which totalled €18,385.60 was closed and transferred to the Bank of Ireland Account and used to
  pay for the new toilet at St. Patrick's Church Ballinamuck.
- \*The Capital expenditure i.e. the toilet in Ballinamuck was €18,160
- \*\*Sundry expenses include €2,440.25 for security upgrade for St. Mary's Church and House, Drumlish
- The Six Dues Collections for the upkeep of the priests for 2018 totalled £27,117. The difference in the pay out is due to the inclusion of some Christmas Dues for 2017 which came in in 2018. Alternative Dues envelopes are provided at the back of the churches for those who don't use the normal envelope system, but still wish to support the priests of the parish. We thank all parishioners who continue to support us and encourage us through their prayers, friendship and financial aid.
- Planned projects for 2019: The seating in St. Mary's Drumlish, and the upgrading of the heating system and window insulation in St. Mary's Church Drumlish and resurfacing of grounds at St. Patrick's Church Ballinamuck
- If you use the services of the priests and/or parish facilities, but for some reason have overlooked the support of the parish and its priests, we ask you to reflect on this in 2019. Young families also have duty of care for their parish and their priests, but many only use the parish/priests for the sacraments and funerals. Please reflect.
- To all who continue to support our parish/priests we thank you most sincerely.
- Note: Church Gate collections are not the Parish responsibility. They are independent of the Parish and should have a Garda Permit. All Church Gate collections are accountable to their own organisations and regulations. We ask again that such collections should be taken up at a reasonable distance from the Church gate entrance—preferably on the opposite side of the Church gate entrance.
