Her talk traced the history of the Catholic Church's work over the last quarter of a century, in tackling the horrors of child abuse and ensuring that our Church communities are as safe as possible. Our diocesan trainers ensure we are up to date with current procedures, our Designated Persons respond swiftly, sensitively and effectively. I thank our Parish Representatives who carry out their important work at local level to ensure standards are high and procedures are followed.
