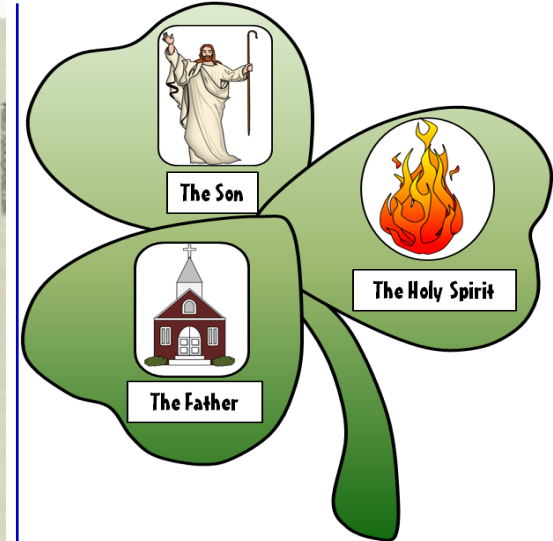
## The Irish Martyrs, 20 June
