Feasts of All Saints & All Souls

- Friday next is the feast of All Saints and is a Holy Day. Vigil Mass in Drumlish on Thursday at 8 p.m. and Mass on Friday at 11 a.m.
- Mass in Ballinamuck on Friday at 7 p.m.
- Saturday is the feast of all Souls. Mass in Drumlish at 11 a.m. and Ballinamuck at 10 a.m.
- Anyone wishing to have their departed remembered in Masses during the month of November are asked to fill in the forms provided at the Church entrance and drop them into the Box at the front of the altar.

Conditions for Indulgences

From 12 o'clock on 1 November until midnight on 2 Nov., all who have

- confessed,
- received Communion
- prayed for the Pope's intentions (one Our Father and Hail Mary, or any other prayer of one's choice) can gain one plenary indulgence - applicable only to the souls of the departed - by visiting a church or oratory and there reciting one Our Father and the Apostle's Creed.

From 1 - 8 November the faithful who visit a cemetery and pray for the dead may gain a plenary indulgence once per day - applicable only to the Holy Souls. Conditions a, b, c, above apply also for this.
