At a recent meeting of the Longford deanery, Bishop Francis has asked that, due to the fall off in people attending Mass and the growing shortage and ageing profile of the priests of the Diocese, every parish should cut back on the number of Masses at the weekends. In the short term that would mean one Mass in each church at the weekend for smaller or rural parishes. It would mean only one Mass in Drumlish and Ballinamuck at the weekend.
