Funeral Regulations

Arising from Government statements 31st March 2020 the following are the current regulations regarding funeral services:

- Immediate family members not exceeding 10 persons may attend funeral services, burial and cremations.
- The social distancing regulation of 2 metres continues to apply.
- Individual parishes may need to put in place special restrictions to respond to specific local circumstances e.g. a small church.
- At a funeral Mass the sign of peace is not exchanged by a handshake and Holy Communion is not to be distributed.
- These regulations apply to all funerals including those arising out of COVID-19 deaths.

Holy Week Reflection: To be a Christian!

It is silence when our words would hurt;
