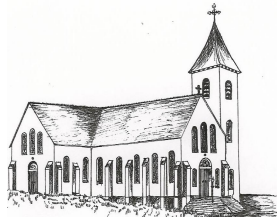

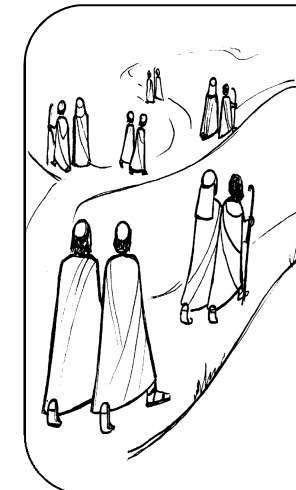
Baptism
