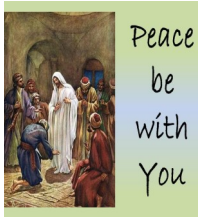
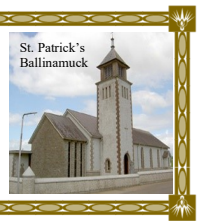

Level 5 Covid-19 Government Regulations

- ♦ **Sacraments and devotions:** All other ceremonies cease for the duration of Level Five including Baptism and the Sacrament of Penance. Novenas and other devotional practices may take place on line only, with no congregation present.
- ♦ **Funerals:** With effect from 24th December up to 10 mourners may attend at a funeral service.
- ♦ **Weddings:** With effect from Sunday 3rd January 2021 the number of guests permitted to attend is reduced to 6.

Gospel Witness—Turkey: Syriac Monk Imprisoned

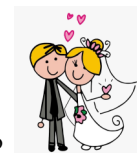


A Syriac Orthodox monk, Fr. Aho, has been sentenced to 25 months in prison by a Turkish court. The court accused him of aiding terrorism. His alleged crime? Giving bread to PKK fighters who showed up at his monastery and asked the priest for food. Fr. Aho refuses to lie and does

not deny giving the PKK members food, but is insistent that his actions were not political. Rather Fr. Aho was acting under Christian charity, and would have given the bread to anyone who asked him for food... [Postscript: Fr. Aho is one of thousands who are suffering persecution because of their fidelity to the Gospel and a witness to the Resurrection]
