



New Covid-19 Regulations From 10th May

- ♦ **Religious Services:** Public celebration of Mass will recommence from 10th May 2021
- ♦ **Funerals:** Maximum 50 mourners at service. No other events to take place
- ♦ **Weddings:** Maximum 50 guests at service. Maximum 6 guests at indoor reception or 15 outdoors
- ♦ **Baptisms:** The number permitted to attend baptism in the Church is limited to 10
