Baptism

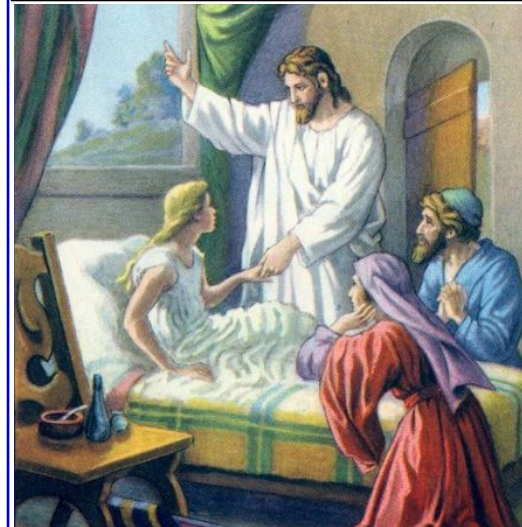
Luke Gerard Robinson s/o Gerard & Hazel, 16 Mill Race was baptised and welcomed into our faith community last weekend. Congratulations to all.

- **Weddings:** Maximum 50 guests at Church service. Wedding receptions can have up to 25 people in attendance
- **Baptisms:** The number permitted to attend baptism in the Church is limited to 10
