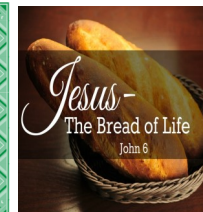

**Accord Catholic Marriage Care Service CLG**

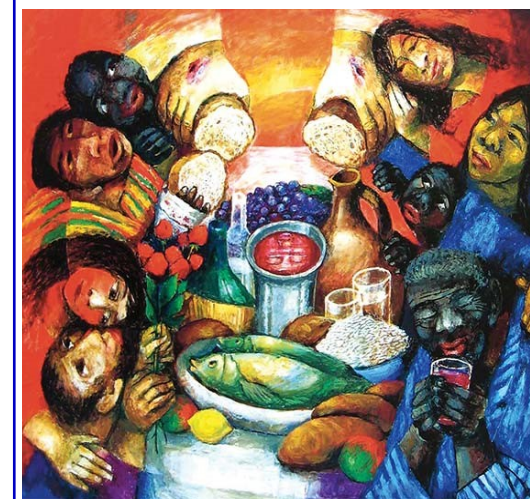

**New Covid-19 Regulations From 5th August**

- ♦ **Baptisms:** From Thursday 5 August, Baptism services may proceed. However, they must follow all protective measures and social gatherings afterwards should be avoided.
- ♦ **Funerals:** Maximum 50 mourners at service. No other events to take place
- ♦ **Weddings:** Maximum 50 guests at Church service.
- ♦ **First Communions & Confirmations:** It is advised that religious ceremonies such as First Holy Communions and Confirmations should not take place at this time.
