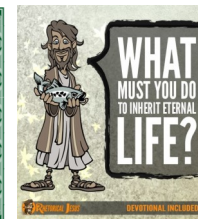
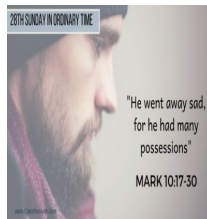

4. Enter Church through main door and exit church via side doors

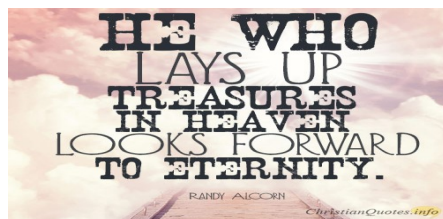
It is the personal responsibility of each person to adhere to these four principles.
