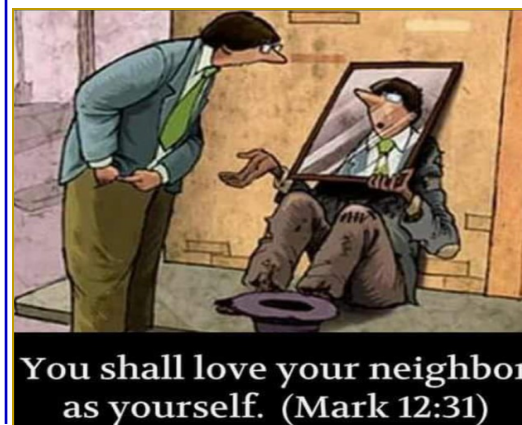

### Feast of All Saints & All Souls

Monday, 1st November is the feast of All Saints. Masses on Monday in Drumlish at 11 am & 8 pm and Mass in Ballinamuck at 7 pm.  
Tuesday is the feast of all Souls. Masses in Drumlish at 10 am & 8 pm. and in Ballinamuck at 7 pm

Those who wish to have their deceased family members remembered in Masses during the Month of November should fill in the leaflet which is at the Church entrance and place your intentions in the Box Shrine in the Sanctuary.

Indulgences may be gained as follows:  
From 12 o'clock on 1 November until midnight on 2 Nov., all who have  
a) confessed,  
b) received Communion  
c) prayed for the Pope's intentions (one Our Father and Hail Mary, or any other prayer of one's choice) can gain one plenary indulgence - applicable only to the souls of the departed - by visiting a church or oratory and there reciting one Our Father and the Apostle's Creed.  
From 1 - 8 November the faithful who visit a cemetery and pray for the dead may gain a plenary indulgence once per day - applicable only to the Holy Souls. Conditions a, b, c, above apply also.



### Covid-19 Regulations from 22nd October

**"Religious services and weddings can proceed without capacity limits but with all other protective measures remaining in place."**

(Government Press Release 19th October 2021).

The following regulations are in operation in our Diocese as and from 22nd October 2021:

- Those with symptoms should not to attend church
- Hand sanitisers available at the doors
- Social distancing to continue
- One way systems to continue
- Wearing of face coverings to continue
- The celebrant and Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion to wear face coverings and sanitise hands before and after distribution
- No handshake as a sign of peace
- Communion on the hand only
- Ventilation of the church
- Choirs may sing while observing the guidelines of the HPSC - have a socially distant performance following risk assessment
