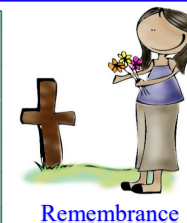

Upon his instillation Canon 419 operates: *When a see is vacant and until the designation of a diocesan administrator, the governance of a diocese devolves upon the college of consultors unless the Holy See has provided otherwise. (Canon 419)*
