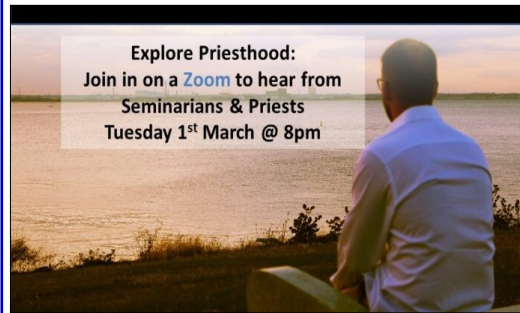

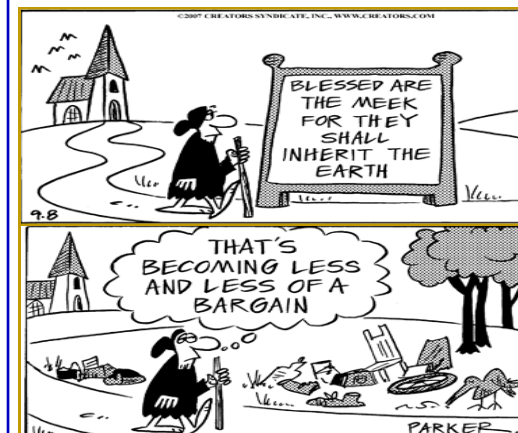

The Corporal Works of Mercy

- 1 Feed the Hungry
- 2 Give drink to the thirsty
- 3 Clothe the naked
- 4 Shelter the homeless
- 5 Comfort the imprisoned
- 6 Visit the sick
- 7 Bury the dead

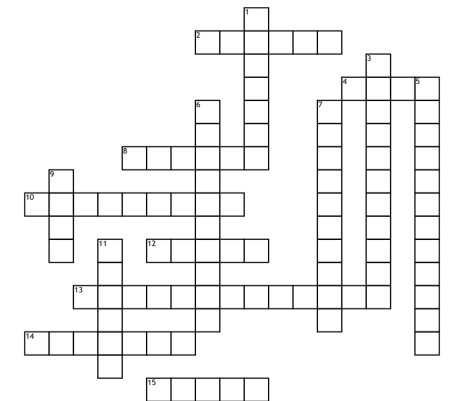
The Spiritual Works of Mercy

- 1 Admonish sinners
- 2 Instruct the uninformed
- 3 Counsel the doubtful
- 4 Comfort the sorrowful
- 5 Be patient with those in error
- 6 Forgive offenses
- 7 Pray for the living and the dead
