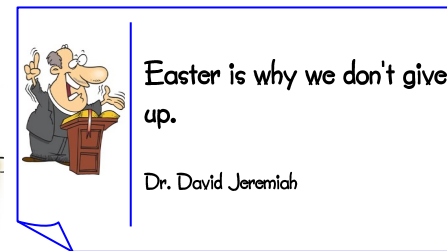
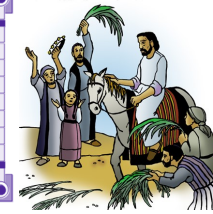

**Arrangements for Holy Week 2022**

As we are now down to one priest in the parish, coupled with the smaller numbers attending, it is now necessary to restructure the pattern of our Holy Week celebrations. I ask all parishioners to treat the ceremonies as a parish celebration and not as two distinct areas. Think along the lines of 'Fr. Manning Gaels' a united family where Christ is at the heart of all our celebrations. The ceremonies are as follows:

**Holy Thursday:**

7 p.m. : Mass of Last Supper in St. Patrick's Ballinamuck  
8 p.m.: Mass of Last Supper in St. Mary's Drumlish followed by Adoration until 11 a.m.

**Good Friday:**

3 p.m. Celebration of the Passion & Veneration of the Cross in St. Mary's Drumlish  
6 p.m.: Stations of the Cross in Ballinamuck starting at the Church and ending at the new cemetery. The various parish organisations are invited take part in carrying the large Cross from station to station.

**Easter Vigil:**

8 p.m. Mass in St. Mary's Drumlish

**Easter Sunday:**

9.30 am: St. Patrick's Ballinamuck  
11.00 am: St. Mary's Drumlish
