Synodal Pathway

As the Church moves into a new and challenging period, Pope Francis has called for a Synod in 2003. His call for a synodal Church has three aspects to it: communion, participation and mission. The synodal process that Pope Francis proposes to us has this objective: to set out, together, in mutual listening, in sharing ideas and projects, to show the true face of the Church: a hospitable 'house', with open doors, inhabited by the Lord and animated by fraternal relationships. Two quotes from the preparatory document can inspire us on this journey:

"The ability to imagine a different future for the Church and her institutions, in keeping with the mission she has received, depends largely on the decision to initiate processes of listening, dialogue, and community discernment, in which each and every person can participate and contribute." (n.9)

"We recall that the purpose of the Synod, and therefore of this consultation, is not to produce documents, but 'to plant dreams, draw forth prophecies and visions, allow hope to flourish, inspire trust, bind up wounds, weave together relationships, awaken a dawn of hope, learn from one another and create a bright resourcefulness that will enlighten minds, warm hearts, give strength to our hands. (n.32)

What does synod mean?

synod, (from Greek synodos, "assembly"), in the Christian church, a local or provincial assembly of bishops and other church officials meeting to resolve questions of discipline or administration. Corresponding words from the Thesaurus : assembly, congress, convention, convocation, council, gathering, get-together, meeting.
