



Corpus Christi Reflection

Today's feast is a offers an opportunity to pause and ask ourselves an obvious question, 'Why do we do this?" 'Why do we gather on Sunday for Eucharist?' Many of us are from a generation where we were told that it was a mortal sin not to! However, with Covid restrictions, the fact is that a lot of people have simply fallen out of the habit of "Mass" attendance. They haven't been going and the sky didn't fall in so why go? The answer lies in looking at the opening line of the Gospel for today. "Jesus made the crowds welcome and talked to them about the Kingdom of God and he cured those who were in need of healing!"
