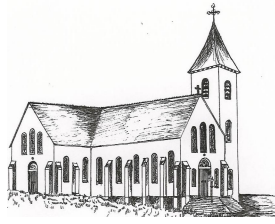
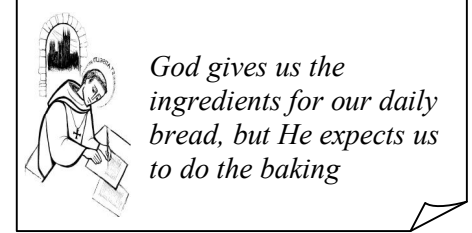

Feast of All Saints and All Souls

- Thursday next is the feast of All Saints and is a Holy Day of obligation. Vigil Mass in Drumlish on Wednesday at 8 p.m. and on Thursday at 11 a.m. Mass in Ballinamuck on Thursday at 7.30 p.m.
- Friday is the feast of all souls. Masses in Drumlish at 8 p.m. and Ballinamuck at 7.30. It is also the First Friday. The sick and housebound will be attended.

Conditions for Indulgences

From 12 o'clock on 1 November until midnight on 2 Nov., all who have
a) confessed,
b) received Communion
c) prayed for the Pope's intentions (one Our Father and Hail Mary, or any other prayer of one's choice) can gain one plenary indulgence - applicable only to the souls of the departed - by visiting a church or oratory and there reciting one Our Father and the Apostle's Creed.

From 1 - 8 November the faithful who visit a cemetery and pray for the dead may gain a plenary indulgence once per day - applicable only to the Holy Souls. Conditions a, b, c, above apply also.

If you don't receive a packet, it means that you didn't use the envelopes last year to contribute to the support of the parish or the support of the priests of the parish.
