## Money Matters

- The envelopes for the coming year will be ready soon. This time the envelope is inclusive of the whole parish (Drumlish/Ballinamuck) and will extend to the end of 2013. This is to facilitate tax reclaims, whereby the parish can claim back taxes for PAYE workers who contribute þ250 or more during the financial year.
- To help defray costs we are cutting back on the number of envelopes this yearò only those who have used the envelope system to contribute to the offertory/ priests dues and other collections, will receive a packet this year. If you don't receive a packet, but would like to be part of the parish system, this can be arranged.
- Due to the new arrangements, all the envelope numbers this coming year will be changed, and is likely to do so each year depending of the changing population and contributors.
- Because of Banking regulations, if you are paying Priests Dues using cheques, please enter "Priests" or "Clergy" as the payee.
- In these difficult times, we thank you for your support over the year, and ask those, who through neglect or otherwise, don't contribute, to give it some thought for the coming year.
- A new parish pastoral council and finance committee will be put in place in the new year.
