What is Pentecost?

In the Acts of Apostles St Luke tells us about how the disciples experienced the Holy Spirit like fire and strong wind. They then started telling others about Jesus' life, death, and resurrection. Pentecost is often referred to as the 'birthday of the Church' because it marks the moment when the Holy Spirit came upon the Apostles and empowered them to spread the message of Jesus Christ to the world. It is a time of reflection, renewal, and celebration, and a reminder of the importance of sharing our faith with others. The word 'Pentecost' comes from the Greek word which means "fiftieth," referring to the fact that the holiday occurs 50 days after Easter.
