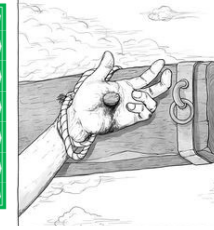
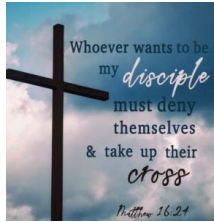



**St Ciarán of Clonmacnois • Memorial 9 September**

Growing up, Ciarán was renowned for his love of animals and vice-versa. When he went to study with Finian of Clonard, he brought his own cow with him to the monastery, a common enough practice in itself. The milk yield of the cow was anything but common, however, and she produced sufficient for the whole monastery! When he was dying Ciarán remained down-to-earth and unselfish, his missionary zeal undiminished. He told his disciples: *'Go ye, let my relics bleach in the sun like the bones of a deer; better for you to dwell in heaven with me, than here with my relics.'*
