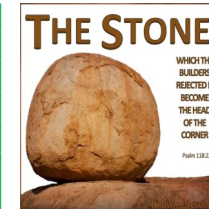

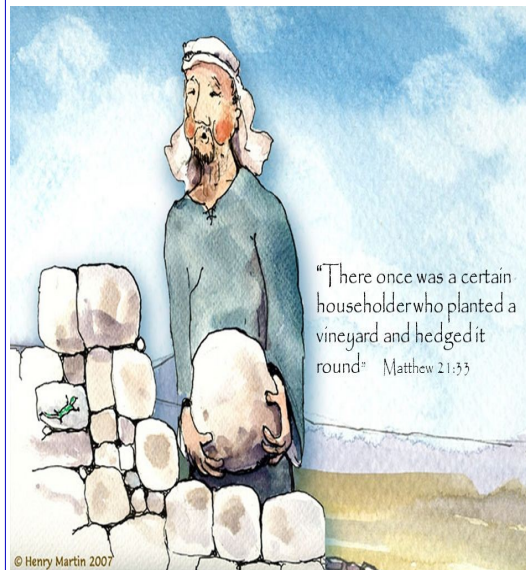

Life through the Lens of the Gospel

The target audience of today's parable are the Jewish chief priests and elders portrayed here as rejecting Jesus and his teaching and, as a consequence, losing out on what God is offering them. The parable is also a cautionary tale of the destructive effects of greed—doing violence to the rights of others which eventually destroys the greedy themselves. The vineyard of the Lord is image of God's people. As we look at the vineyard we have been given, we can ask ourselves 'are we good tenants?' "It was the stone rejected by the builders that became the keystone. This was the Lord's doing and it was wonderful to see."
