

# Continue to Pray for the Synod in Rome

In October 2021 Pope Francis convened the whole Church in Synod. Since that time there have been gatherings of the faithful at parish, national and continental levels. Following this universal gathering in Rome for the Synod on Synodality, a second universal gathering of this Synod will also take place during October 2024. The aim of the Synodal Process is to provide an opportunity for the entire People of God to discern together how to move forward towards being a more synodal Church in the long-term. The theme of the Synod is "For a Synodal Church: Communion, Participation, and Mission." These three dimensions are profoundly interrelated. They are the vital pillars of a Synodal Church.

## **World Mission Sunday**

Next Sunday is Mission Sunday. We remember our missionaries—lay and religious—who continue the work of developing the Kingdom of God and bring the Good News of the Gospel to all parts of the world. We pray especially for those who work in difficult and hostile situations that the Holy Spirit will continue to give them the faith, hope and courage necessary. The following is a short extract from Message of Pope Francis for Mission Sunday.

## Dear brothers and sisters!

For this year's World Mission Sunday, I have chosen a theme inspired by the story of the disciples on the way to Emmaus, in the Gospel of Luke (cf. 24:13-35): "Hearts on fire, feet on the move". Those two disciples were confused and dismayed, but their encounter with Christ in the word and in the breaking of the bread sparked in them the enthusiastic desire to set out again towards Jerusalem and proclaim that the Lord had truly risen. In the Gospel account, we perceive this change in the disciples through a few revealing images: their hearts burned within them as they heard the Scriptures explained by Jesus, their eyes were opened as they recognized him and, ultimately, their feet set out on the way. By meditating on these three images, which reflect the journey of all missionary disciples, we can renew our zeal for evangelization in today's world.
