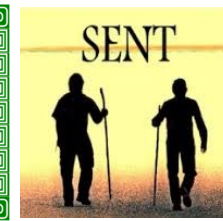

Children and Information Technology

Anne Marie Lee is a retired Public Health Nurse and Healthcare Tutor and offers the following tips for parents and how to engage with children:

- ♦ **Decide when to give your child a phone and what type of phone.**
- ♦ **Talk to your child, appropriately for their age, about safety in using information technology.**
- ♦ **Once your child has a smartphone, he/she must be warned to be extremely careful who he/she gives their number to.**
- ♦ **Switch on all safety apps on the child's phone.**
- ♦ **Always have the code for their phone and check it regularly.**
- ♦ **No phone, laptop or TV in the bedroom**
- ♦ **If the phone is missing, block it as you are responsible for the cost of calls made.**
- ♦ **It is illegal to access the phone of an 18-year old without permission**
- ♦ **Encourage socialisation and communication, guide your children in developing their talents.**
- ♦ **Give them opportunities to embrace diversity in race, culture and social status.**

Some thoughts on today's scripture

“Wallet, keys, phone...” Many of us have a mantra we recite as they leave home, to ensure we are ready for the day. Jesus sends us out with less, inviting us to trust, to be ready to engage with and respond to the world around us. Many people allow themselves to become defensive and protective, aware of slights and insults. Jesus invites his followers to shake off and leave behind acrimony, resistance and unfriendliness. The disciples were allowed to take only one thing with them - a staff - something to lean on, to support them as they journeyed. Who, or what, is my 'staff'? Where do I find supports in living out my life as a disciple today? We ask Jesus to help us to keep our eyes on him and his heart rather than letting our hearts be restricted or narrow.
