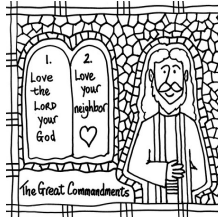

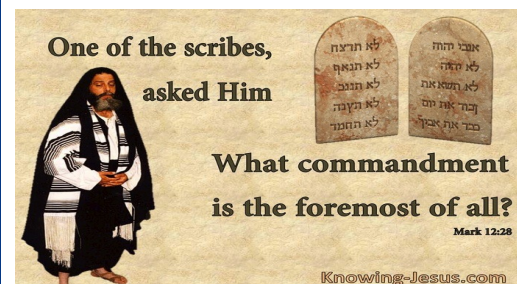

Application forms for Admission to Junior Infants September 2025 are now available:

1. On the school website – www.drumlshns.ie available from November 18th 2024
2. Emailing a request for an admission form on office@drumlshns.ie
3. Collection by siblings or a nominated person.
4. Calling the school on 043 3324065 requesting an admissions form to be sent to your address.
5. Calling to the school personally.
6. Any of the above methods are welcome, but in themselves do not constitute an application.
7. All of the details relating to your child will be kept electronically on our admin software and in hard copy in a locked cabinet.

1. The school will commence accepting applications on November 18th 2024
2. The school will cease accepting applications on December 6th 2024 @12 noon
3. The date by which applicants will be notified of the decision on their application January 24th 2025
4. Places must be accepted by January 31st 2025
Note: Failure to accept an offer within the prescribed period above may result in the offer being withdrawn.

The school will consider and issue decisions on late applications in accordance with the school's admission policy. Total number of places available 26
