Excerpts from a 'Letter to a Young Disciple' by St Columbanus (543-615). Feast: 23 November

Be helpful when you are at the bottom of the ladder and be the lowest when you are in authority. Be simple in faith but well trained in manners. Be demanding in your own affairs but unconcerned in those of others.

Be guileless in friendship, astute in the face of deceit. Be tough in times of ease, tender in hard times. Be pleasant when things are unpleasant, and sorrowful when they are pleasant.

Disagree when necessary, but be in agreement about the truth.

Be slow to anger, swift to learn, slow also to speak, as St James says, equally swift to listen.

Be gentle to the weak, firm to the stubborn, steadfast to the proud, humble to the lowly.
