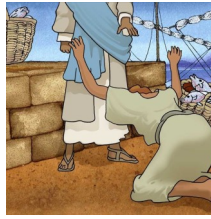
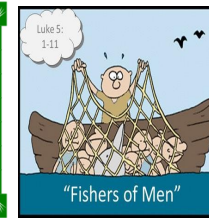

Some thoughts on this scripture

This is not an argument for the Prosperity Gospel which tells us that if we do the right things God will bless us with abundance of wealth and health—and that if we don't get the promised abundance it is our own fault. The real message here is in the last few words: 'they left everything and followed him'. They left behind them their great catch, because they had been captivated instead by the person of Jesus. We too are to 'seek first the kingdom of God' – we are to live in God's world and judge the world's affairs from that vantage point.
