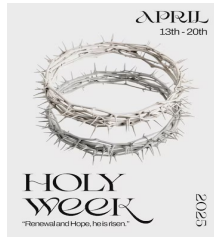

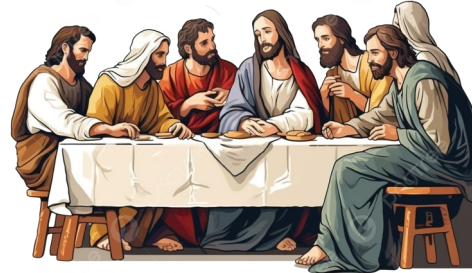
Palm Sunday

Good Friday

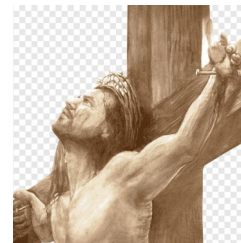
Lord, sometimes we lose sight of the
