Reflection

Thomas was a modern man, finding faith hard, like many people today. He was let down by the others who ran away, the leader denied Jesus, his trust in the group of apostles had been abused. He didn't want much more to do with them. He had got tired of it all. He wanted to believe but needed a sort of proof. But faith grows within a community. That's why we baptise children, because faith grows from the beginning of life. In community, the disciples found faith in the risen Christ. Thomas, for some reason, was not with them when the Lord came. Separated from the community, he found faith more difficult. Faith in the Lord, while personal, is not a private affair. In the faith of one, the faith of another may be strengthened. [Irish Jesuits—Sacred Space]

Pope Francis, born Jorge Mario Bergoglio, served as the head of the Catholic Church from 2013 to his death on April 21, 2025. Jorge Mario Bergoglio was born on December 17th 1936 in Buenos Aires, Argentina, the eldest of five children to Mario Jose Bergoglio, an accountant from Italy, and Regina María Sívori, the daughter of Italian immigrants. He was ordained a priest on December 13th, 1969 with the Jesuit religious order, which he would lead as Argentina provincial superior during the country's dictatorship that began in the 1970s. On May 20th 1992 he was named auxiliary bishop of Buenos Aires and in 1998 succeeded Cardinal Antonio Quarracino as archbishop of the Argentine capital. He became the archbishop of Buenos Aires in 1998 and was created a cardinal in 2001 by Pope John Paul II. Following the resignation of Pope Benedict XVI on 28 February 2013, a papal conclave elected Bergoglio as his successor on 13 March. He was the first pope from the Americas, and the first from the Jesuit order. Known for his humility and reform efforts, Francis was a strong advocate for social justice, environmental protection, and the rights of marginalized people. On June 18, 2015 he Issued his environmental manifesto "Laudato Si" ("Praised Be"), calling for a cultural revolution to correct the "structurally perverse" global economic system that exploits the poor and has turned Earth into "an immense pile of filth." His vision of Church is that of a Synodal Church where all walk together as Pilgrims of Hope. He chose Francis as his papal name in honour of Saint Francis of Assisi.
