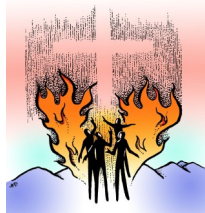

### Deaths

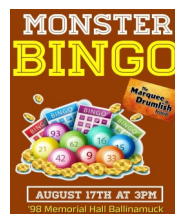
