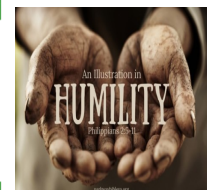

Reflection



Meals often feature in
Jesus' parables and in the
key moments of his public
life - Cana, Martha and
Mary, the meeting with
Magdalene, the last supper.
He remains present to us in
the sacred meal of the
Eucharist. It is at meals,
sitting, relaxed, with time
to listen, that we are most

alive to one another. Yet meals are disappearing.
Many families find that fast food, freezers and micro-
waves, the presence of TV, the pull of other
commitments, have almost put an end to family
meals. In the USA 40% of meals are eaten in cars!
Have I a place for meals in my life?
