Zacchaeus Meets Jesus

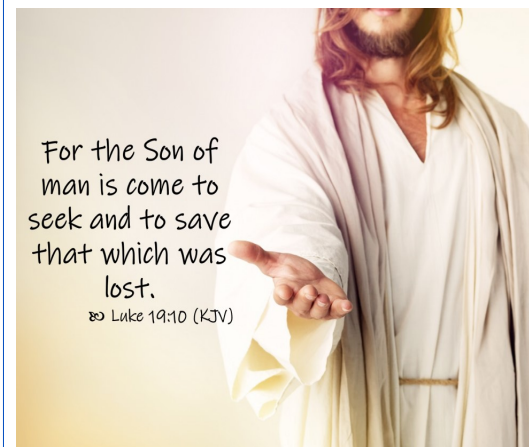
