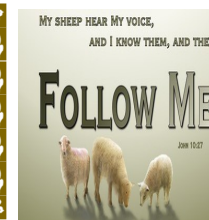

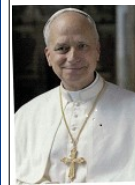

**A Prayer For Vocations to the Diocesan Priesthood**

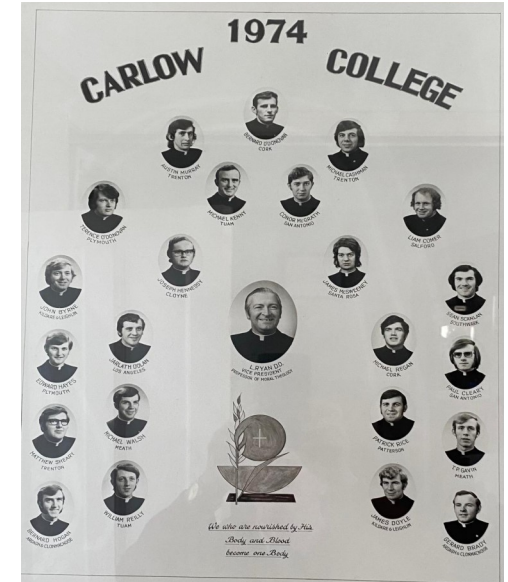


Lev 11:22
