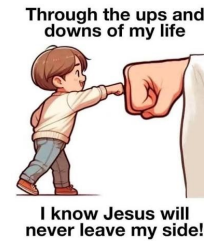

**Cemetery Sunday Arrangements**

The blessing of graves takes place this Sunday, 5th July:

- ♦ Ballinamuck after 9.30 Mass

- ♦ Kilmahon 12.30 p.m. approx.

As in recent years I ask families to bring their own Holy Water or you can have water blessed on the day in the cemetery. At a fixed point during the prayers, families will be invited to sprinkle their own family plots. The Celebrant will not be blessing individual graves but will lead the prayers in the cemetery. Thank you for your understanding and cooperation. Maintenance of cemeteries is an ongoing challenge, so please support the collections which will be taken up at each cemetery. Also those who have loved ones interred in the cemeteries are asked to bring home any rubbish, dead flowers, broken wreaths and please do not pile them up inside the gate or in any other part of the cemetery.
