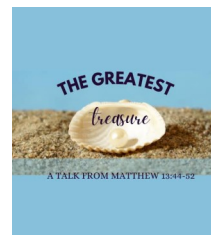

The above appointments will take effect from the weekend of the 6th of September 2026.

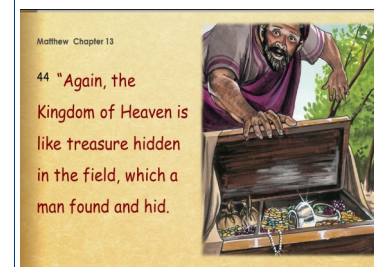
