Bishop's Statement on Abortion Legislation [Extract]

- **A time to reflect**
We are at a defining moment for our country. The Gospel of life is at the heart of the message of Jesus. He came that we may have life and have it to the full (Jn 10:10). The Gospel challenges us to work for a world in which the dignity and beauty of every human life are respected.
- **A time to uphold the right to life**
The right to life is the most fundamental of all

rights; it is the foundation of all other rights. No individual has the right to destroy life and no State has the right to undermine the right to life. Catholic Church teaching is clear: where a seriously ill pregnant woman needs medical treatment which may put the life of her baby at risk, such treatments are ethically permissible provided every effort is made to save both the mother and her baby. This is different from abortion, which is the direct and intentional taking of the innocent life of the unborn. No matter what legislation is passed in any country, abortion is, and always will be, gravely wrong.

- **A time for clarity and truth**
The Government is under no obligation to legislate for the X case. Legalising the direct and intentional destruction of the life of an unborn baby can never be described as -life-saving or -pro-life. While good health can normally be restored, life, once taken, can never be restored.
- **A time for freedom of conscience**
Freedom of conscience is a fundamental human right. A State that truly cherishes freedom will respect the conscience of its citizens, including its public representatives, on such an important human value as the right to life.
- **A time to decide: a time to act; a time to pray**
We ask our public representatives to uphold the equal and inviolable right to life of all human beings, even if this means standing above other pressures and party loyalties. Some mothers today are facing difficult or crisis pregnancies. Other people who have had, or who have assisted with abortions, may be re-living what happened in the past. They deserve to receive all the love, support and professional care that they need. Every human life is precious, every human life is beautiful, every human life is sacred. Choose life!
