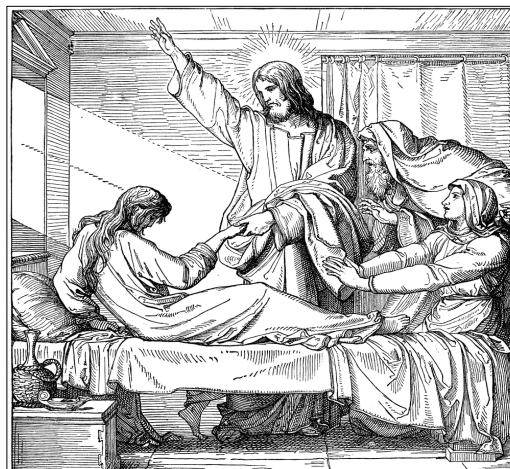
All-Ireland Rally for Life 2015
