Following our September Safeguarding Committee meeting, Bishop Paul and Committee members are committed to get training up and running for all involved in the church – Clergy, Local Safeguarding Representatives, Sacristans, Youth Choir leaders, etc. As you know no training has taken place since Autumn 2019, due to Covid and due to lack of trainers. Training for **ALL** Local Safeguarding Representatives will take place on Saturday 2nd November 2024. This will be a Full Day Training. New Safeguarding Policy: During 2023 and early 2024 the National Board concluded the revision of the Church's Safeguarding Children Policy and Standards: The new Policy, A Safe and Welcoming Church; Safeguarding Children Policy and Standards for the Catholic Church in Ireland, 2024 has been approved by both the IEC and AMRI and came into effect from 11 June 2024. Mission Sunday

World Mission Sunday is the Holy Father's annual appeal to support overseas mission and missionaries. All offerings made on behalf of World Mission Sunday become part of the Holy Father's Universal Solidarity Fund which supports missionary activities in over 1,150 young dioceses; mostly in Africa, Asia, and Latin America. As young dioceses grow, so do their needs. The needs of young dioceses vary. anything from a motorbike so a priest can celebrate Mass in remote villages, to a community hall so local people can gather in safety, or more urgently, vaccinations and medicines so that parish dispensaries can protect vulnerable children. For this Mission Sunday Pope Francis has chosen the theme: 'Go and invite everyone to the banquet.' Mission, he said is a tireless going out to all men and women, in order to invite them to encounter God.
